## ECB RETURN TO CRICKET PLAN FOR STEP 4 JULY 2020

### Club Waiver

The Committee of Fawley Cricket Club has reviewed the ECB Return to Cricket Plan for Step 4 issued on 8<sup>th</sup> July and has ensured the Club follows the Guidelines issued.

As members of the Club all those attending any planned activity at the Ground must be aware of the rules and be prepared to follow them. Any breach of these rules will lead to the Club Member being asked to leave site by either the Duty Manager or a Member of the Committee.

All participants (players, coaches, officials, volunteers and spectators) should check for symptoms of COVID-19. In line with current UK Government Guidance, **if an individual is symptomatic and/or living in a household with a possible COVID-19 infection they should remain at home and follow UK Government guidance.** In addition, any participants who have been asked to isolate by NHS Test and Trace because they are a contact of a known COVID-19 case, must not exercise outside their home or garden and must not exercise with others. •

**The Committee of Fawley Cricket Club would like to make all participants aware of the increased risk of transmission of covid-19 when partaking in socially distanced group activity and would like you to be aware that you are opting in to take part at your own risk.**

As a Club Member you should be aware that all Clubs have been asked to support the NHS Test and Trace efforts by keeping a temporary record of all participants in any cricket activity for 21 days and support NHS requests for data if needed. In order for the club to do this you must complete our **2020 covid-19 compliance form** which also notes that you have read this Club Waiver and are happy with its contents.
